A motion to accept the minutes was made by Mike LaPera and seconded by Peg Callaghan. ***Motion Passed***

Treasures Report was read by Mike LaPera for Treasurer Don Denight. A motion to accept the report was made by Mike LaPera seconded by Mike Barry. A question was raised by President Joyce concerning the publicity acct. Doug advised that \$ 1.00 of all the SFAA members dues should be put into publicity. Don Denight will go back to January and calculate the number of members and have a total at the next meeting.

Officers Reports

President/ NFAA Director – Doug Joyce

Doug gave a summary of the directors meeting held at the Mid Atlantics sectional. Some of the highlights were: We will shoot a 300 round at the 2008 Indoor Mids March 1 & 2nd with the last 4 ends counting inside out X' s. February 29th will be the option day for clubs to shoot. There will be no late fee charged.

The Outdoor mid Atlantics will be held at Watkins Glen on June 28 & 29th. It will be a 28 field 14 animal and 28 hunter round. There will be a \$10.00 late fee for this tournament.

Doug presented information on the NFAA's program titled **ASAP** (After School Archery Program) a discussion followed about the details involved. New Jersey will not be participating in this program at this time.

Executive VP – Peg Callaghan

Peg gave a brief report on the Outdoor Mid Atlantics.

Doug thanked Peg and Garden State Archers for a well organized tournament and a job well done. Peg has been in contact with Gene and work will begin very soon on the 2008 state handbook.

Garden State Archers presented the bill for the targets for the State Field Championship. The bill was submitted to the treasurer. Doug said that the state only pays for the paper targets. We do not pay for them to be mounted on cardboard. A lengthy discussion followed.. A suggestion was made to minutes reflect that the state does not pay to have targets mounted on the cardboard. After further discussion we decided that we would look into the difference in the price and shipping for having the targets mounted on cardboard or just the paper targets. Peg said she would do this and have the information for our next meeting. A final decision will be made at that time.

3-D awards have been purchased and we should have enough for the next few years unless the amount of shooters increases.

60 –Large plaques and plates have been purchased for the 2007 state field championship and the 2008 Indoor state championship. It may be necessary to purchase some additional large plaques depending on the number of registered shooters. The plates are in the hands of Paul's and they will engrave them as needed.

Paul's has giving us a wonderful deal on the plaques. Instead of the \$19.50 per plaque rate that Hero's had been charging us we now will be paying \$10.50 per plaque including engraving. Paul's has also offered to engrave the plates for the smaller B & C class plaques free of charge. We will need to purchase additional patches and medals from the NFAA.

Donna still needs to get the computerized award certificate E-mailed to her. She asked who ever has this please get it to her ASAP.

VP Field Archery – Al Liguori

Al has made a sample of the new score card for the 2008 Indoor States. The cards were designed for scoring the double Vegas round. A brief discussion followed on the number of cards to be printed along with the price of printing. Printing of the score cards i.e.: number of cards, printer etc. will be discussed at the next meeting.

A motion was made by Don and seconded by Al to shoot the double Vegas round for the 2008 Indoor States. *Motion Passed*

An additional motion was made by Mike LaPera seconded by Mike Barry. To make this a one score tournament along with the option to double register (if you're shooting two different styles). If a shooter chooses to double register they will be charged for each registration. *Motion Passed*

The 2008 Indoor State Championship will be held on March 29 & 30 th at three locations. Wopena, Garden State Archers @ Sportsmen center. And the Buckshorns Sportsmen club.

Weekly Awards – Claire Reimer

Claire's report was read by Don Denight in her absence. All clubs are current with the exception of Cape May. Don has Cape May's shoot report and check and will forward the report to Claire.

Councilman NFAA Mid-Atlantic- Mike LaPera

Mike as councilmen thanked Garden State Archers for a well organized Mid Atlantic Sectional shoot. Mike also asked our state clubs to stay in the rotation for sectional shoots. Mike gave us an update on NFAA news. As of today there are no dates or places scheduled for the Stanislawski open (Pittsburg) shoot. There was a phone meeting discussing the sale of NFAA offices in Redlands CA. An offer of \$900,000.00 was made to the NFAA. That offer is 30 – 40% above current appraised value. If the office is sold they would set up temporary office in CA. A letter has been sent out asking for bids for a new location. Mike also stated that two council men have resigned.

Old Business

Just a question on the traditional archers and their intention pertaining to the SFAA was brought up. At this time there are no answers.

New Business

An update on dates for next years shoots were discussed. The Indoor States will be held on March 29 & 30th @ WoPeNa, Garden State Archers @ Sportsmen center & Buckshorn Sportsmen. The Indoor Mid Atlantic will be held on March 1 & 2nd @ WaXoBe, WoPeNa and the Buckshorn Sportsmen. The 3D State Championship will be held August 2&3rd @ WaXoBe and the State Field Championship will be held August 23&24th @ Cape May.

A discussion began on giving Black Knights an exclusive date for their Big Foot shoot . The discussion was brief and inconclusive. The discussion on exclusivity continued pertaining to the state field championship warm up date. (Traditionally held 2 weeks before the state championship). This date will be exclusive.

The Sportsman show will be January 10-13th 2008. And the SFAA will have a booth at the show, WaXoBe will be having a Archery presentation and asked the other state clubs to join them.
