VP Field Archery- Elmer McKishen

I have been working on getting the schedule for 2011 and formatted and to be printed by the January Meeting the old format couldn't be used so the price of the schedules will be considerably higher than last year for 1500 copies due to the fact that the printer had to reformat the information because we added 14 new entries that we didn't have last year with Victory Sportsmen and also adding the 5 state meetings the printer will have the schedules in time for the January meeting.

I also asked the printer to give me a quote on outdoor championship score cards which she did the price for 300 cards will be \$151.00 which we can cut in half 150 white and 150 any other color for the same price, also for 500 cards which we can cut in half also with 250 white and 250 in any other color for the same price. I told her that I had to bring the quote back to the January meeting to get approval which she said would be OK.

I haven't contacted WA-XO-BE to see how many 3-d targets they plan to have for the marked and unmarked 3-d championship if they have more than 30 targets I will have to get a quote on score cards and have them printed because this is a scheduled state championship shoot which we supply the score cards and the workbook logs which I will have on DVD to be e-mailed to WA-XO-BE chairman which they haven't chosen yet, also they haven't chosen the tournament chairman for the outdoor championship at this time which I also will send that chairman a DVD with the workbook logs also.

Garden State has gotten back to me with their indoor championship chairman after that I have been working on the indoor championship application which I e-mailed their chairman to make sure all their information was correct and for direction to Sportsmen Center to be put on the second sheet of the application along with Buckshorns and WA-PO-NAs directions to be given to the webmaster so he can post them on the website also will e-mail them to all the clubs so they can have them for their members.

Also I have been working on getting the outdoor championship application ready to be approved by the tournaments host but they must get the chairman to me so I can finish up the application and Information sheet finished up and e-mailed to the webmaster to be put on the website and I also will e-mail it to all the clubs so they can have it for their members. I have been changing the outdoor application to make it more shooter friendly and removing any wrong information so not to cause any disruptions.

Also I have been working on master workbook logs for the indoor and outdoor championships along with the marked and unmarked 3-d championship so that all the final results will be on the same form and the shooters log will all be the same not what the hosting club made up. All indoor and outdoor hosting clubs will have a hard copy as well as dvd will all the forms they need to host either indoor or outdoor championship.
