I still have a ton of the indoor championship score cards for the NFAA 300 round still left over from several years back which I am using just extending the line for inside out X's from three to six.

I have been contacting the hosts clubs for the indoor state championship for their contacts and Tournament Chairman so I can get the indoor application finished up and get it to Art to be put on the website. Also I will be sending the host clubs a disc containing all the information they need for logging shooters address, style, division and directions including the finical report that they must send the Secretary/Treasurer and the result sheet to myself so I can put them all together and post the final results and be sent to the VP of Awards to get the award tags printed for their plaques.

Just so everybody knows Cape May traded with WA-XO-BE for the outdoor State championship for 2011 and Cape May will host the 2012 Championship, Also the marked and unmarked 3-D championship will be held at WA-XO-BE as soon as they select their Tournament chairman and any other contact for these two events I will start working on appropriate applications and have them approved by WA-XO-BE and sent to Art to be put on the website and to all the clubs so they can have them for their archers.

In finishing up my report I learned a very valuable lesson to always have your documents backed up on disc also in my case also on the clubs computer so I will not have to start from the beginning and redo all the information I collected from everybody.

One other thing which I almost forgot to put in my report I will also be sending a information disc containing index, directions, shooter log sheet and result log for the
