Officer's reports

President/NFAA Director- Doug Joyce

The NFAA annual meeting report from the February meeting in Vegas was distributed.

Doug briefly touched on some of the meetings highlights.

The 50 yard issue for traditional archers was once more turned down.

The Vegas shoot again had increased registration.

This is the last year on the Pittsburg contract.

The Life membership changes in the NFAA was explained: Senior life members that join before June 1, 2007 will be grandfathered in.

Executive VP – Peg Callaghan

Peg had nothing new to report. President Joyce thanked her for the excellent work done on the 2007 SFAA handbook.

VP Awards- Donna Denight

Donna reported that the Indoor state awards have been completed and are ready for distribution. All awards that can be distributed by the clubs BCR can be taken tonight and all others will be mailed out. She will be in contact with Paul's Awards and trophies for prices and availability.

VP Field Archery- Al Liguori

The New Jersey SFAA web site has been updated with the Indoor State Championship results. This year's state championship had over 120 registered shooters this represents an increase from last years number. Score cards formats for future shoots was discussed.

Registration forms for the Outdoor Mid-Atlantic Sectional and the New Jersey State Outdoor Championship are available on the SFAA website.

Weekly Awards – Claire Reimer

Claire reported on missing and unpaid shoot reports. These will be submitted by the clubs.

Councilman NFAA Mid-Atlantic- Mike LaPera

Mike reported that the Indoor sectionals were a success. The registered shooters were up approximately 100 shooters. Mike thanked those clubs that hosted the Indoor sectionals. The Outdoor sectionals will be held at Garden State Archers this year Mike reported this is the last year on the contract with the NFAA and Pittsburgh. The NFAA is shopping for a new venue. There will be a 40 yard novelty round shot at Pittsburg. The NFAA is exploring the possibility of a new round for future years.

Old Business

Buckshorn Sportsmen Club had expressed interest in becoming a NFAA & SFAA chartered club previously. They have completed all the proper forms and applications, forwarded them to Secretary/ Treasurer Donald Denight along with a letter authorizing either Don or Donna Denight as their club representative in their absence. Black Knights (Al Liguori) made a motion to accept their membership and it was seconded by Wa-Xo-Be (Doug Joyce)

Motion Passed

New Business

Doug Joyce brought the Topic of the 2007 Mid Atlantic council meeting to be held at the Outdoor Mid Atlantic Sectionals in June.

A motion was made by Mike LaPera and seconded by Don Denight to have our states NFAA director Doug Joyce to vote in favor of shooting the 300 round (either once or twice, shooters choice) for the 2008 Indoor Mid Atlantic Sectional. ***Motion Carried***

A motion was made by Scott Beard and seconded by Don Denight to have our states NFAA director Doug Joyce to vote in favor of shooting a 28 Field- 14 Animal- 28 Hunter round for the 2008 Outdoor Mid Atlantic Sectional. ***Motion Carried***

Doug instructed any Chartered clubs interested in hosting the 2008 Indoor Mid Atlantic Sectionals, 2008 Outdoor Mid Atlantic Sectionals and the 2008 Indoor State Championships to present to him in writing a formal request letter by June 1, 2007.

Scott Beard made a motion to move the SFAA meetings to the Sportsmen Center in Bordentown, NJ. The Sportsmen center offered the SFAA their facilities free of charge. The motion was seconded by Art Reimer. A vote was taken resulting in a 3- 3 tie. President Doug Joyce broke the tie with a no vote. The SFAA meetings will continue to be held at the WA-XO-BE club.

Vice President of Awards Donna Denight brought the topic of awards for the 3D Championships to the table. A discussion followed with suggestions and ideas for the type of award to be given. Some of the suggestion was Belt Buckles and Tags.

A motion was made by Mike LaPera and seconded by Art Reimer to go with the Tags. Tags will have the State Seal along with the phrase 3D Champion on them.

Motion Carried

A broad discussion concerning the \$5.00 advertising or sanctioning fees and the \$1.00 per shooter fees started. From the discussion several motions were made.

A motion was made by Peg Callaghan and seconded by Don Denight to reduce the advertising fees by 50% for the SFAA clubs ads in the state hand booklet. A vote was taken and passed 4 Yes - 1 No – 1 Abstain ***Motion Carried***

A motion was made by Mike LaPera to not accept new life membership in the SFAA effective Jan 1, 2008. Seconded by Scott Beard. A vote was taken and passed 4 Yes - 1 No – 1 Abstain ***Motion Carried***

A motion was made by Art Riemer seconded by Scott Beard saying: At all SFAA championships the host club will receive 50% of the total registration, based on the head count. *Motion Carried*

Good & Welfare

Scott made an announcement that Garden State Archers would like to have an entry from each club for their chili cook off. He also asked if President Doug Joyce would help in the judging. Doug agreed

Motion to adjourn by Mike LaPera seconded by Scott Beard.
